Grand President Thomas, joined the Amphitrite Chapter #175 in San Bernardino, California in District 20, transferred to Cadmus Chapter #165 in Paramus, New Jersey, and is now a member of Agape Chapter #336 in Wyckoff, New Jersey. She has been a member of the AHEPA family for more than 40 years since joining the Maids of Athena at the age of 14. She has served numerous leadership positions with the Daughters of Penelope, including most recently, Grand Vice President.
