Please do not send applications by fax or email as they will not be considered. Please contact the Scholarship Chairman with questions.

- We urge you to be sure your application is **complete** to avoid disqualification. Therefore, it is strongly recommended that the applicant ensure that an additional person(s) – like your parents and/or student counselor - review your application to check whether it is complete before submission to the Scholarship Chairman to avoid later disappointment

- Make a copy of the completed application before mailing for your own records
